Each year SCIP recognizes one individual who has made significant and meritorious contributions to the CI profession. The Meritorious Award is the highest honor bestowed by the Society.

Candidates for the Meritorious Award may come from any field, including academia, business, and government. The candidate need not be a SCIP member, although the extent by which a candidate contributes to the Society may have implications during the Meritorious Award evaluation process. An active member of the SCIP Board of Directors is not an eligible candidate for the Meritorious Award. Whatever their career, candidates must have made a significant and meritorious contribution to the competitive intelligence profession. That contribution must be



documented and supported by several individuals who can personally attest to the importance of the candidate's contribution. Professional actions and/or achievements that would qualify a candidate for a Meritorious nomination would include, but not be limited to the following:

- Advanced, nurtured, and promoted the CI profession across disciplines - in the academic, government, and business communities
- Achieved notable publicity for CI as a result of personal accomplishments
- Achieved recognition and respect from CI peers in the academic, government and business communities
- Improved the public understanding of the CI profession
- Practiced and advanced high ethical standards

**Contribution to CI Profession** - For example: advanced, nurtured, and promoted the CI profession across disciplines – in the academia, government, and business communities.

**Public Recognition as Notable CI Professional** - Achieved notable publicity for CI as a result of personal accomplishments as a CI practitioner, academic, consultant, author, etc.; achieved recognition and respect from CI peers in the academic, government, and business communities; practiced and advanced high ethical standards.

**Promotion of CI Profession** - For example: improved the public understanding of the CI profession.
